HOW TO PREPARE THE ASSIGNMENT?

- Find two news reports/articles in any Turkish or other foreign journal, magazine or newspaper;
 - first one about a successful and
 - second one about an unsuccessful solution of the same public policy problem.
- Then answer the following questions:

ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS ONLY

1. What is the common problem in both news? Describe the problem in two sentences.
2. In the first news, describe the unsuccessful solution to the problem and explain in a paragraph why this solution failed.
3. In the second news, explain in a paragraph how the same problem is solved successfully.
4. Compare the two stories. What are the reasons for failure? If the successful solution is not from Turkey, can this solution be implemented in Turkey? How? Again 1-2 paragraphs are enough
5. Also include the web image of the news and other visual material you find related to the topic.

GRADING (OUT OF 20 POINTS)

- Are the questions answered by using evidence?
 - -2 points for each question answered without evidence
- Is the presentation professional? (Correct spelling & grammar, etc.)
 - If not, -2 points
- Is anything unnecessary written except the questions, answers & evidence? (No cover page, introduction, discussion, results etc, only write the questions & answers)
 - -2 points
- Is the file Powerpoint?
 - If not -2 points
- Is there more than 10 slides?
 - -2 points
- Is the filename given as desired?
 - Example: KAY-203-METE-YILDIZ(YOUR-NAME)-INDIVIDUAL-ASSIGNMENT.ppt(x)
 - -2 points
