

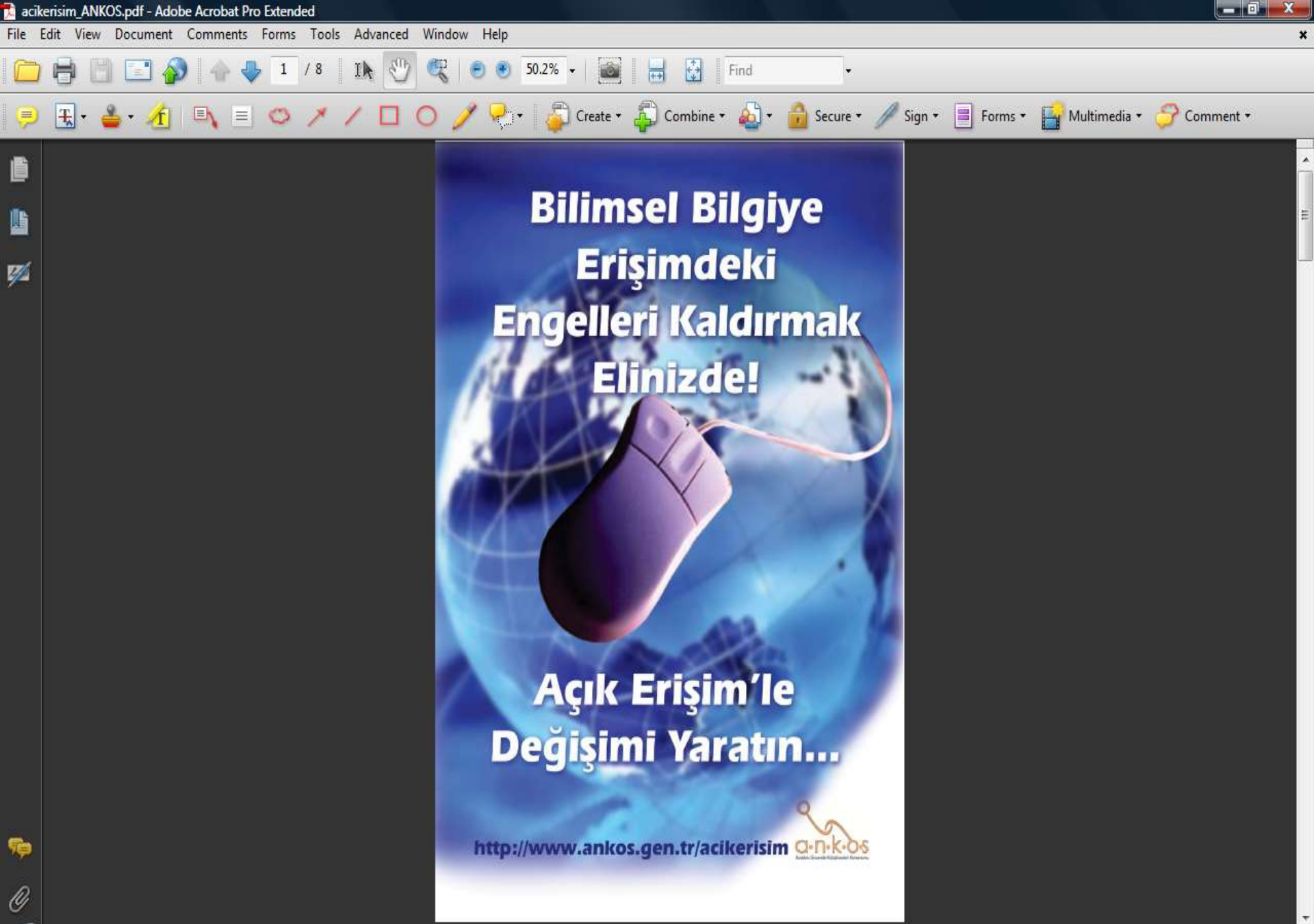

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Açık Erişim: Tanım

- ❑ “[Açık erişim] eserin tam bir sürümü... açık erişime, sınırsız dağıtımına, birlikte çalışabilirliğe ve uzun dönemli arşivlemeye olanak sağlamak için... en azından bir çevrimiçi arşivde depolanır.” (Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities)
- ❑ “... dijital, çevrimiçi, ücretsiz, lisans ve telif sınırlandırması olmayan...” (Suber, 2004)





Herkesin coğrafi konumdan ve zamandan bağımsız olarak bilgiye erişmesi...

Günümüzde dünya çapında yayınlanmakta olan yaklaşık 24.000 hakemli dergiye araştırmacıların makalelerini göndermeleri, hakemlik sürecinden geçerek bunların yayınlanması ve bu dergilere kütüphaneler tarafından abone olunması şeklinde gerçekleşmekte olan bilimsel iletişim kriz içindedir. Son 20 yıl içinde dergi birim fiyatları tüm dünyada enflasyonun çok üstünde artmış, başta Amerika ve Avrupa olmak üzere bir çok ülkede kütüphaneler çok sayıda dergi aboneliklerini iptal etmek zorunda kalmışlardır. Dünyada yılda yaklaşık 2.5 milyon makale yayınlanmakta, araştırmacı sayısı ve dolayısıyla yayınlanan makale sayısı hızla artmaktadır. En zengin ülkelerdeki kütüphanelerin bile, ücretli dergilere abone olarak araştırmacıları için gerekli olan tüm yayınlara erişimlerini sağlayabilmesi mümkün değildir.

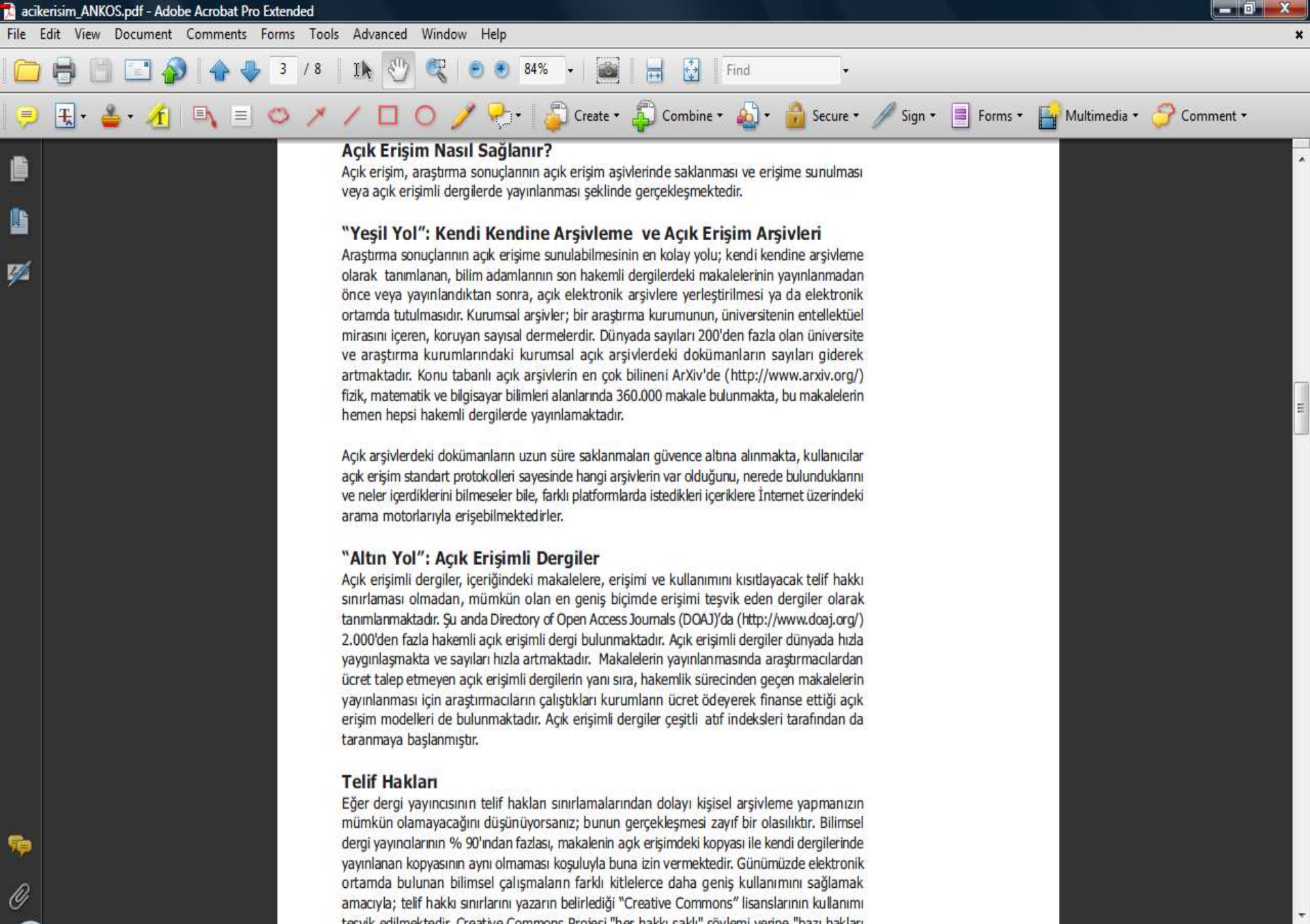
Diğer yandan İnternet; araştırmacılar arasındaki iletişim, araştırma sonuçlarının paylaşılması ve elektronik yayıncılık konusunda büyük bir devrim yaratarak; araştırma sonuçlarının daha çabuk yayınlanmasını ve herkesin coğrafi konumdan ve zamandan bağımsız olarak bilgiye erişmesini sağlamıştır.

Açık Erişim Nedir?

Araştırma sonuçlarına mümkün olduğu kadar geniş kitlelerin erişimi, tüm dünyada araştırma ve eğitimin vazgeçilmez önceliklerinden biridir. Bilim insanları araştırma sonuçlarının yayınlanmasını, okunmasını, yayınlarının atf almasını ve diğer araştırmacılarla bilgi alışverişinde bulunmayı istemektedirler. İnternet sayesinde araştırmacılar ve kütüphaneler, araştırmacıların makalelerinin yayınlandığı dergilere abone olsun ya da olmasın, konferans bildirilerine, tezlere ve araştırma raporlarına erişebilmektedirler. Bu kısaca açık erişim olarak nitelenmektedir.

Açık Erişim Ne Değildir?

Teknik raporlar, tezler ve çalışma raporlarının yanı sıra hakemli dergi makalelerinin ve konferans bildirilerinin ücretsiz erişilebilir elektronik kopyaları açık erişimin içeriğini oluşturmaktadır. Açık erişim hakemli yayıncılığı ortadan kaldıran, ikinci sınıf, maliyeti düşürülmüş, araştırmacıların kendi kendilerine yayın yapma şekli değildir. Basit bir deyişle, tüm araştırmacı kitlesinin araştırma sonuçlarına İnternet ortamında ücretsiz olarak erişimlerinin sağlanmasıdır.



Açık Erişim Nasıl Sağlanır?

Açık erişim, araştırma sonuçlarının açık erişim aşivlerinde saklanması ve erişime sunulması veya açık erişimli dergilerde yayınlanması şeklinde gerçekleşmektedir.

“Yeşil Yol”: Kendi Kendine Arşivleme ve Açık Erişim Arşivleri

Araştırma sonuçlarının açık erişime sunulabilmesinin en kolay yolu; kendi kendine arşivleme olarak tanımlanan, bilim adamlarının son hakemli dergilerdeki makalelerinin yayınlanmadan önce veya yayınlandıktan sonra, açık elektronik arşivlere yerleştirilmesi ya da elektronik ortamda tutulmasıdır. Kurumsal arşivler; bir araştırma kurumunun, üniversitenin entellektüel mirasını içeren, koruyan sayısal dermelerdir. Dünyada sayıları 200'den fazla olan üniversite ve araştırma kurumlarındaki kurumsal açık arşivlerdeki dokümanların sayıları giderek artmaktadır. Konu tabanlı açık arşivlerin en çok bilineni ArXiv'de (<http://www.arxiv.org/>) fizik, matematik ve bilgisayar bilimleri alanlarında 360.000 makale bulunmakta, bu makalelerin hemen hepsi hakemli dergilerde yayınlamaktadır.

Açık arşivlerdeki dokümanların uzun süre saklanmaları güvence altına alınmakta, kullanıcılar açık erişim standart protokolleri sayesinde hangi arşivlerin var olduğunu, nerede bulunduklarını ve neler içerdiklerini bilmeseler bile, farklı platformlarda istedikleri içeriklere İnternet üzerindeki arama motorlarıyla erişebilmektedirler.

“Altın Yol”: Açık Erişimli Dergiler

Açık erişimli dergiler, içeriğindeki makalelere, erişimi ve kullanımını kısıtlayacak telif hakkı sınırlaması olmadan, mümkün olan en geniş biçimde erişimi teşvik eden dergiler olarak tanımlanmaktadır. Şu anda Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)'da (<http://www.doaj.org/>) 2.000'den fazla hakemli açık erişimli dergi bulunmaktadır. Açık erişimli dergiler dünyada hızla yaygınlaşmakta ve sayıları hızla artmaktadır. Makalelerin yayınlanmasında araştırmacılardan ücret talep etmeyen açık erişimli dergilerin yanı sıra, hakemlik sürecinden geçen makalelerin yayınlanması için araştırmacıların çalıştıkları kurumların ücret ödeyerek finanse ettiği açık erişim modelleri de bulunmaktadır. Açık erişimli dergiler çeşitli atıf indeksleri tarafından da taranmaya başlanmıştır.

Telif Hakları

Eğer dergi yayıncısının telif hakları sınırlamalarından dolayı kişisel arşivleme yapmanızın mümkün olmayacağını düşünüyorsanız; bunun gerçekleşmesi zayıf bir olasılıktır. Bilimsel dergi yayınlarının % 90'ından fazlası, makalenin açık erişimdeki kopyası ile kendi dergilerinde yayınlanan kopyasının aynı olmaması koşuluyla buna izin vermektedir. Günümüzde elektronik ortamda bulunan bilimsel çalışmaların farklı kitlelerce daha geniş kullanımını sağlamak amacıyla; telif hakkı sınırlarını yazarın belirlediği "Creative Commons" lisanslarının kullanımı teşvik edilmektedir. 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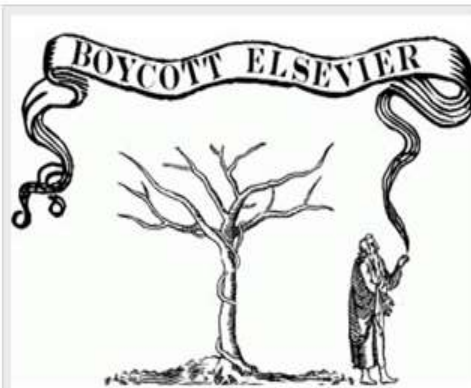

Academic research is behind bars and **an online boycott** by 8,209 researchers (and counting) is seeking to set it free...well, more free than it has been. The boycott targets Elsevier, the publisher of popular journals like *Cell* and *The Lancet*, for its aggressive business practices, but opposition was electrified by Elsevier's backing of a Congressional bill titled the **Research Works Act** (RWA). Though lesser known than the other high-profile, privacy-related bills SOPA and PIPA, the act was slated to reverse the **Open Access Policy** enacted by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) in 2008 that granted the public

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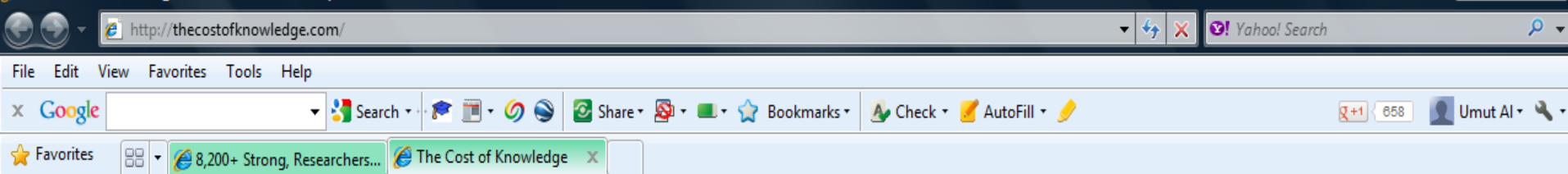

Academics have protested against Elsevier's business practices for years with little effect. These are some of their objections:

1. They charge exorbitantly high prices for subscriptions to individual journals.
2. In the light of these high prices, the only realistic option for many libraries is to agree to buy very large "bundles", which will include many journals that those libraries do not actually want. Elsevier thus makes huge profits by exploiting the fact that some of their journals are essential.
3. They support measures such as SOPA, PIPA and the ~~Research Works Act~~, that aim to restrict the free exchange of information.

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ELSEVIER WITHDRAWS SUPPORT FOR THE RESEARCH WORKS ACT

At Elsevier, we have always focused on serving the global research community and ensuring the best possible access to research publications and data. In recent weeks, our support for the Research Works Act has caused some in the community to question that commitment.

We have heard expressions of support from publishers and scholarly societies for the principle behind the legislation. However, we have also heard from some Elsevier journal authors, editors and reviewers who were concerned that the Act seemed inconsistent with Elsevier's long-standing support for expanding options for free and low-cost public access to scholarly literature. That was certainly not our intention in supporting it. This perception runs counter to our [commitment to making published research widely accessible](#), coming at a time when we continue to expand our access options for authors and develop advanced technologies to enable the sharing and distribution of research results.

We welcome indications that key research funders are more willing to talk to publishers to explore collaborative approaches. This is a good sign because we firmly believe that more cooperation and partnership between funders and publishers is the best way to expand free public access.

While we continue to oppose government mandates in this area, Elsevier is withdrawing support for the Research Work Act itself. We hope this will address some of the concerns expressed and help create a less heated and more productive climate for our ongoing discussions with research funders.

Cooperation and collaboration are critical because different kinds of journals in different fields have different economics and models. Inflexible mandates that do not take those differences into account and do not involve the publisher in decision making can undermine the peer-reviewed journals that serve an essential purpose in the research community. Therefore, while withdrawing support for the Research Works Act, we will continue to join with those many other nonprofit and commercial publishers and scholarly societies that oppose repeated efforts to extend mandates through legislation.

We are ready and willing to work constructively and cooperatively to continue to promote free and low-cost public access through a variety of means, as we have with research funders and other partners around the world.

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H.R.3699 -- Research Works Act (Introduced in House - IH)

HR 3699 IH

112th CONGRESS

1st Session

H. R. 3699

To ensure the continued publication and integrity of peer-reviewed research works by the private sector.

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A BILL

To ensure the continued publication and integrity of peer-reviewed research works by the private sector.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the `Research Works Act'.

SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEDERAL AGENCY ACTION.

No Federal agency may adopt, implement, maintain, continue, or otherwise engage in any policy, program, or other activity that--

- (1) causes, permits, or authorizes network dissemination of any private-sector research work without the prior consent of the publisher of such work; or
- (2) requires that any actual or prospective author, or the employer of such an actual or prospective author, assent to network dissemination of a private-sector research work.

SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Act:

- (1) **AUTHOR**- The term `author' means a person who writes a private-sector research work. Such term does not include an officer or employee of the United States Government acting in the regular course of his or her duties.
- (2) **NETWORK DISSEMINATION**- The term `network dissemination' means distributing, making available, or otherwise offering or disseminating a private-sector research work through the Internet or by a closed, limited, or other digital or electronic network or arrangement.
- (3) **PRIVATE-SECTOR RESEARCH WORK**- The term `private-sector research work' means an article intended to be published in a scholarly or scientific publication, or any version of such an article, that is not a work of the United States Government (as defined in section 101 of title 17, United States Code), describing or interpreting research funded in whole or in part by a Federal agency and to which a commercial or nonprofit publisher has made or has entered into an arrangement to make a value-added contribution, including peer review or editing. Such term does not include progress reports or raw data outputs routinely required to be created for and submitted directly to a funding agency in the course of research.

DRIVER: Networking European Scientific Repositories

Considered the largest initiative of its kind in helping to enhance repository development worldwide, DRIVER is a multi-phase effort whose vision and primary objective is to create a cohesive, robust and flexible, pan-European infrastructure for digital repositories, offering sophisticated services and functionalities for researchers, administrators and the general public.

DRIVER has established a network of relevant experts and Open Access repositories. DRIVER-II will consolidate these efforts and transform the initial testbed into a fully functional, state-of-the art service, extending the network to a larger confederation of repositories. DRIVER is integral to the suite of electronic infrastructures that have emerged in the worldwide GÉANT network and is hence funded under the e-Infrastructures call of the European Commission's 7th framework programme. It aims to "... optimise the way the e-Infrastructure is used to store knowledge, add value to primary research data and information making secondary research more effective, provide a valuable asset for industry, and help bridging research and education."

Do Open-Access Articles Have a Greater Research Impact?

Abstract

Although many authors believe that their work has a greater research impact if it is freely available, studies to demonstrate that impact are few. This study looks at articles in four disciplines at varying stages of adoption of open access—philosophy, political science, electrical and electronic engineering and mathematics—to see whether they have a greater impact as measured by citations in the ISI Web of Science database when their authors make them freely available on the Internet. The finding is that, across all four disciplines, freely available articles do have a greater research impact. Shedding light on this category of open access reveals that scholars in diverse disciplines are adopting open-access practices and being rewarded for it.

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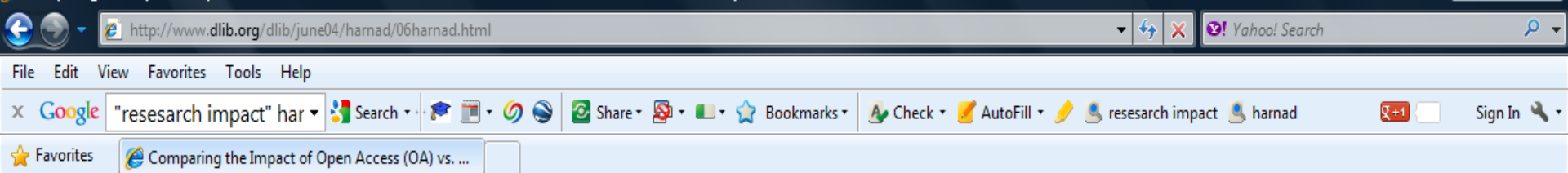

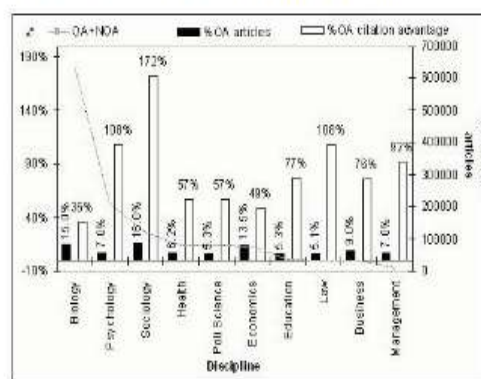

Açık Erişimin Etkisi

Makalelerin basılı olarak yayınlandığı bir dünyada açık erişimden söz etmek imkansızdır. İnternet sayesinde bunu gerçekleştirmek mümkün olmuş; daha fazla sayıda araştırmacı bilimdeki son gelişmelerden haberdar olmaya başlamıştır. Başka bir deyişle açık erişimdeki makaleler daha fazla kişi tarafından okunabilmekte, araştırma sonuçları daha geniş kitlelere ulaşmakta; dolayısıyla yayınların daha fazla atf alma olasılığı artmaktadır. Çeşitli bilim dallarında yapılan son atf analizlerine göre; açık erişimli makalelerin, diğerlerine oranla iki üç kat daha fazla atf aldığı saptanmıştır.



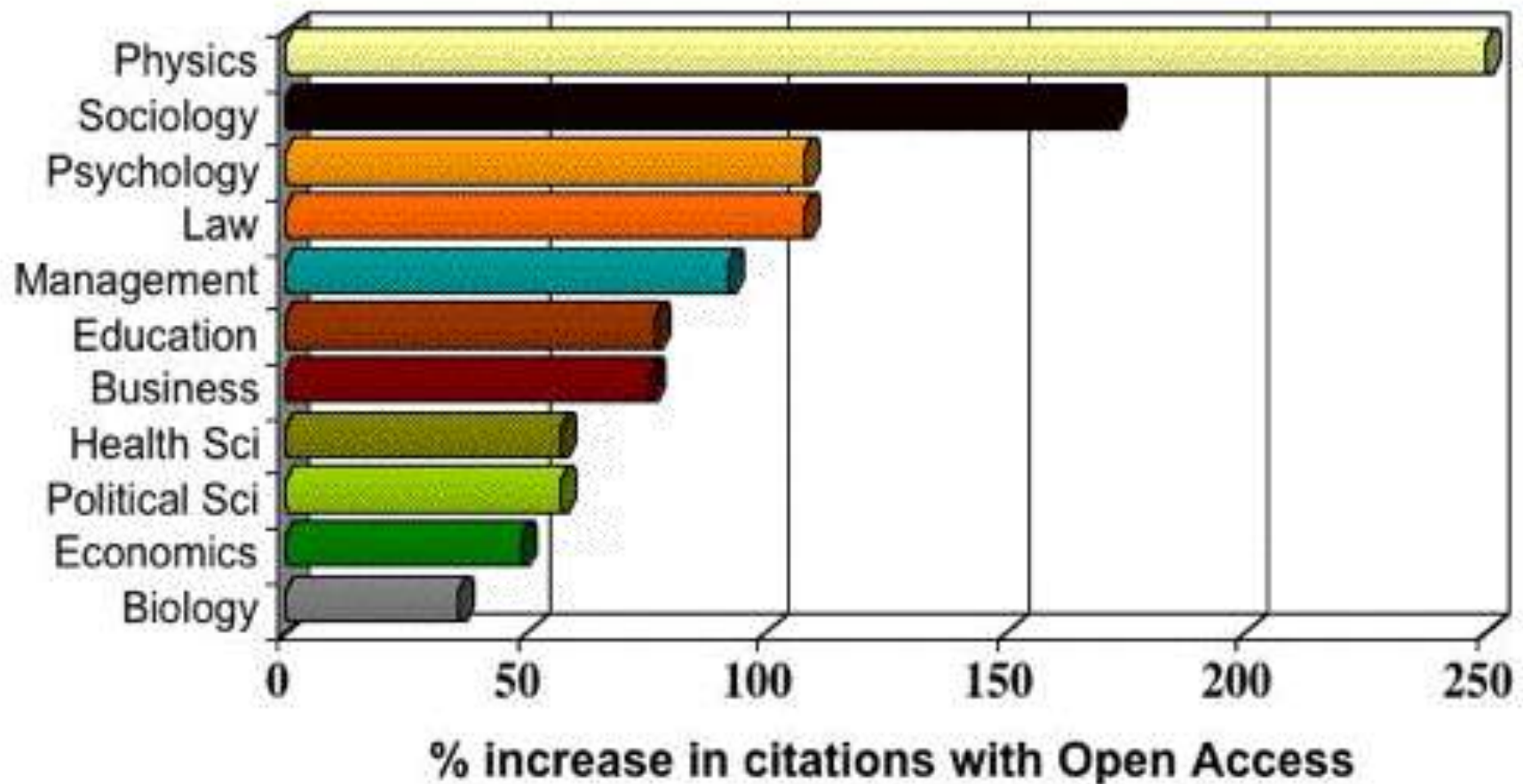

Açık Erişim ve Kamu Yararı

Açık erişim kavramı; kamu kaynaklarıyla finanse edilen ve hakemlik süreciyle bir kalite kontrolünden geçen araştırma sonuçlarının, ücretli dergilerde yayımlandıktan sonra tekrar kütüphaneler yani kamu kurumları tarafından satın alınarak erişime sunulmasındaki çarpıklığın giderilmesi ve bilginin toplumun yararına sunulmasıdır.
